We have been working on patterns this past month. Due to missing so much school in November, we will continue working on patterns as well as shapes. Patterns are an important early math skill. We will start with an AB pattern and work on extending the pattern. These activities can be done at home with various materials. For example, have your child sort socks and then line them up blue, red, blue, red, blue. Then ask your child, what would come next? Try a Shape Hunt game with your children. For example: find something that is the shape of a square. The children have also been learning about Gun Safety with Eddie the Eagle. Your child may be singing the song from the video, "Stop, Don't Touch, Run Away, Tell a Grown Up." The video is available on YouTube if you would like to watch it with your child(ren).
