

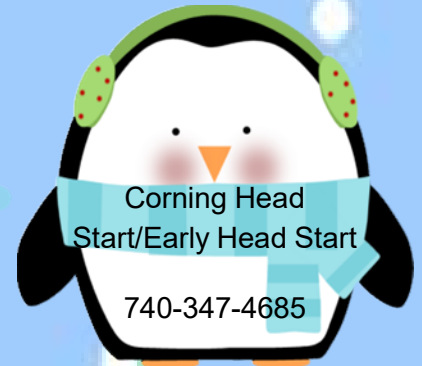

Early Head Start - Ms. Patti will be focusing on Pretend Play. "When children engage in pretend play they are actively experimenting with the social and emotional roles of life." Younger children explore pretend play by imitating actions and behaviors they see. Games such as Peek-A-Boo and how to hold, rock and pat a stuff doll are simple but effective activities that increase social/emotional stability.

Older children engage in symbolic play. This means using one object to represent another. Such as using a block as a cell phone. A simple but easy way to practice this is through a pretend play scenario such as a picnic.

Ms. Patti will also be presenting a variety of nursery rhymes through singing songs such as "Row your Boat" and "Twinkle Little Star." "When children are exposed to singing, they develop a sense of joy and excitement about language, gently unfolding their desire to read and write."
