The children will be working on letter sounds, letter recognition, and counting this month. The teachers will be using the classroom environment to explore letters and numbers by doing scavenger hunts and games like "Little Cat" and "I Spy". We encourage you to do this at home with your child/children as well!

Here are some examples of how you can continue learning in the home:

- Do a scavenger hunt! Ask your child/children things like "Find me something that starts with the letter O" or "Find me something with the letter K on it".
- While you're driving look for letters on signs and restaurants.
- Count while eating goldfish crackers, count while cleaning up toys, or while setting the dinner table, ask questions like "how many forks?"
