This month, teachers will be providing a variety of activities in the classroom related to snow. Children will have the opportunity to explore snow in the sensory table.

Sensory tables allow children to actively explore materials using a variety of tools and their hands. Children learn to problem-solve and develop observation and prediction skills through sensory play.

The children will also be learning the letters of their names by making a snowman out of snowballs with letters on them. These are just a couple examples of the many activities in the classroom that will provide children the opportunity to learn to work together as a team, make predictions, and recall what they have learned.

The children will also continue working on lessons on Talking About Touching. This is presented to the children to teach them about keeping their bodies safe.

Miss Barbara will be sharing information with families on a variety of safety topics during weekly home visits. Children will also have the opportunity to participate in learning activities related to snow. During socializations, children will explore their senses with snow in the classroom setting, and later in the month they will be doing a cooking experiment!
