

Early Head Start

Ms. Patti will be providing learning opportunities that focus on feelings and giving children "words" to label their emotions. Children need to be exposed to words immediately upon birth if not while still in the womb. When language ready, this will give the children the necessary vocabulary to communicate effectively, to label their feelings, and to get their needs met.

EHS will also be creating "I SPY" tubes. I SPY is a simple game which promotes development of social skills such as following rules and taking turns. When children wait for their turn, they are learning how to play and cooperate with others. In addition, social interaction through games build vocabulary and gives children a better understanding of language and how to use it.

Center Based

The center based classroom will be working on activities that promote healthy habits, such as eating a well balanced diet and good oral health. They will discuss the food groups and determine which foods are WHOA, SLOW, or GO foods. For instance, candy is a WHOA food, French fries are a SLOW food and vegetables are GO foods.

In addition, they will be working on identifying feelings, cutting and sorting, and other mathematical skills such as number recognition through games and other learning experiences.
