

The children will be discussing emotions and kindness this month. The teachers will be utilizing many books that involve feelings, conflict, friendships, and kindness.

Here are some examples of how you can continue learning in the home:

A book suggestion: "When Sophie Gets Angry- Really, Really Angry..." by Molly Bang or similar stories. This is a great book about anger and how to deal with those big feelings. Read the story with your child and then discuss why Sophie was angry, ask them to show you their faces for the emotions that you discuss in the story, such as angry, sad, and happy. Try using more complex words to describe those feelings too, such as frustrated, depressed, and elated. If you do not have a particular book you are looking for, you can always search it on YouTube to find a video of someone reading the story, or check out the Laurelville Library.
